#### CONSENT DECREE

The State of Nevada BOARD of Funeral and Cemetery Services ("BOARD") having jurisdiction over licensee ERIC JAMESON LEE ("LEE"), pursuant to NRS 642.470; complaint against said licensee alleging violations of the Nevada statutes and regulations controlling the practice of funeral directors; and the parties being mutually desirous of settling the controversy between them relative to the pending complaint;

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED between the undersigned parties that this matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:

## **VOLUNTARY WAIVER OF RIGHTS**

LEE is aware of, understands, and has been advised of the effect of this Consent Decree, which he has carefully read and fully acknowledged. LEE has had the opportunity to consult with competent counsel of his choice.

LEE has freely and voluntarily entered into this Consent Decree, and he is aware of his rights to contest the charges pending against him. These rights include representation by an attorney at his own expense, the right to file an answer in response to a formal complaint, the right to a public hearing on any charges or allegations formally filed, the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses called to testify against him, the right to present evidence on his own behalf, the right to testify on his own behalf, the right to receive written findings of fact and conclusions of law supporting the decision on the merits of the complaint,

and the right to obtain judicial review of the decision. All of these rights are being voluntarily waived by LEE in exchange for the BOARD'S acceptance of this Consent Decree.

If the Consent Decree is not accepted by the BOARD, no member of the BOARD will be disqualified from further hearing of this matter, by reason of his or her consideration of the Consent Decree and LEE hereby waives any claim of bias or prejudice based upon said consideration by any member of the BOARD in any subsequent disciplinary hearing conducted by the BOARD.

#### JURISDICTION

LEE acknowledges that the BOARD has jurisdiction over him and the conduct alleged in the Complaint. LEE acknowledges that the BOARD has the legal power and authority to take disciplinary action, including, but not limited to, the revocation of his license to practice as a funeral director in Nevada.

LEE acknowledges that the BOARD will retain jurisdiction over this matter until all terms and conditions set forth in this Consent Decree have been met to the satisfaction of the BOARD.

## PUBLICATION OF CONSENT DECREE

LEE acknowledges that at the time this Consent Decree becomes effective, it also becomes a public document and will be reported to the State of Nevada, Legislative Council Bureau, Disciplinary Action Reporting System, and such other national databases as required by law. It is also understood that any meeting during which the BOARD considers and accepts or rejects this Consent Decree is open to the public and that the minutes of the BOARD meeting are a public document, available for inspection by any person so requesting.

#### INDEMNIFICATION

LEE, for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby indemnifies and holds harmless the State of Nevada, the BOARD, the Nevada Attorney General's office and each of their members, agents and employees in their individual and representative capacities against any and all claims, suits, demands, actions, debts, damages, costs, charges, and expenses, including court costs and attorney's fees against

any persons entities as well as all liability, losses, and damages of any nature whatsoever that the persons and entities named in this paragraph shall have or may at any time sustain or suffer by reason of this investigation, this disciplinary action, this settlement or its administration.

#### STIPULATED FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

LEE understands the nature of the allegations under consideration by the BOARD. He acknowledges that the conduct alleged in the Complaint, if proven, constitutes violations of the Nevada Board of Funeral and Cemetery Services Practice Act (NRS and NAC 642) and NRS Chapter 451. He further recognizes that if this matter were to be taken to a disciplinary hearing before the BOARD, there is a substantial likelihood that the following allegations could be proven as true, and that as a result he would be subject to disciplinary action by the BOARD. As such, LEE does not contest the following allegations:

- LEE held a valid Funeral Director license on the date of the alleged violations and continues to hold a valid Funeral Director license from October 4, 2000, through the present day.
- Mr. Lee was the approved managing Funeral Director of Lee Funeral Home and Cremation Services (LFHCS) during all times relevant to the alleged violations regarding this complaint.
  - 3. The Board conducted an inspection in the LFHCS facility on February 12, 2015.
- 4. The inspector found a bucket adjacent to the cremator containing ashes comingled with metal folder fasteners.
- 5. An employee of the location stated that the establishment used the retort to burn documents and the bucket contained ashes from burning recent documents.
- 6. NRS 642.480(11) states that unprofessional conduct includes violation of any provision of this chapter, any regulation adopted pursuant thereto or any order of the Board.
- 7. NRS 642.480(12) states that unprofessional conduct includes violation of any state law or municipal or county ordinance or regulation affecting the handling, custody, care or transportation of dead human bodies.

If the Board determines that a person who holds a funeral director's license, a permit to operate a funeral establishment or a license to conduct direct cremations or immediate burials has committed any of

- (a) Refuse to renew the license or permit;
- (b) Revoke the license or permit:
- (c) Suspend the license or permit for a definite period or until further order of the Board:
- (d) Impose a fine of not more than \$5,000 for each act that constitutes a ground for disciplinary action;
- (e) Place the person on probation for a definite period subject to any reasonable conditions imposed by the Board;
  - (f) Administer a public reprimand; or
- (g) Impose any combination of disciplinary actions set forth in paragraphs (a) to (f), inclusive.
  - 2. The Board shall not administer a private reprimand.
- 3. An order that imposes discipline and the findings of fact and conclusions of law supporting that order are public records.
- 12. LEE does not contest the allegations and acknowledges that as a consequence he is subject to discipline pursuant to the above charges and statutory provisions.

#### STIPULATED ADJUDICATION

LEE stipulates that pursuant to the authority of NRS 642.473, the BOARD will administer a public reprimand. In addition, LEE agrees to comply with the following conditions:

- 1. Within thirty (30) days of the approval and execution of this Consent Decree, LEE shall pay three hundred fifty six dollars (\$356.00) in legal and investigative fees and five hundred dollars (\$500.00) in administrative fines.
- a. No grace period is permitted. Full payment not actually received by the BOARD on or before the thirty days as indicated above, shall be construed as an event of default by LEE.
- b. In the event of default, LEE agrees that his funeral director license shall be immediately suspended. The suspension of LEE's license shall continue until the unpaid balance is paid in full and the suspension is subject to being reported to all appropriate agencies.
- c. LEE acknowledges that the BOARD has the legal power and authority to take action against him, including instituting debt collection actions for unpaid monetary assessments in this case.
- LEE must attend at least a three (3) hour course pre-approved by the BOARD Executive Director on the issue of ethics as it relates to the funeral industry within sixty days (60) from this BOARD approved Consent Decree.
- 3. LEE shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and orders of the BOARD, which are not inconsistent with this Consent Decree, pertaining to the practice as a funeral director in this State. From the date of execution of this Consent Decree until LEE satisfies the payment requirements of subsection 1 of this Stipulated Adjudication section, LEE shall report any and all violations to the BOARD in writing within seventy-two (72) hours.
- 4. From the date of execution of this Consent Decree until LEE satisfies all of the terms of this Stipulated Adjudication section, LEE is required to notify the BOARD in writing within seventy-two (72) hours after any change in employment as a funeral director, including

self-employment, consulting or volunteering. Any notification of termination or change of employment shall contain a full explanation of the circumstances surrounding it.

5. LEE agrees that he will be financially responsible for all requirements of this Consent Decree, including the cost of any reasonable financial assessments by the BOARD for the Cost of monitoring his compliance or carrying out the provisions of this Consent Decree upon a determination of non-compliance with the provisions of this Consent Decree.

#### **VIOLATION OF TERMS OF CONSENT DECREE**

LEE understands that the BOARD may, upon thirty (30) days' notice to LEE, convene a hearing for the limited purpose of establishing that he violated the terms of this Consent Decree. If such a hearing results in a finding of a violation of this Consent Decree, the BOARD may impose any penalty upon LEE authorized by NRS 642.473 including, but not limited to, revocation of his license to practice as a funeral director in the State of Nevada.

LEE agrees to waive his right to appeal the substantive legal basis of the original disciplinary action, which is the basis for this Consent Decree. In the event an alleged violation of the Consent Decree is taken to hearing and the facts which constitute the violation are determined to be not proven, no disciplinary action shall be taken by the BOARD.

#### **ACCEPTANCE BY THE BOARD**

This Consent Decree will be presented and accepted by the BOARD with a recommendation for approval from the Attorney General's Office at its next meeting.
